

The Denver Broncos selected Shannon Sharpe out of Savannah State in the seventh round of the 1990 NFL Draft. He retired 14 seasons later as the all-time leader in catches, XXXV victory. yards and touchdowns by a tight end.

His breakout year came during his third season when he led the Broncos in receiving with 53 catches for 640 yards to earn his first of eight Pro Bowls. Other than an injuryshortened 1999 campaign, Sharpe never caught less than 60 passes in a season for the remainder of his career.

In 1993, he was named first-team All-Pro for longest TD catch in NFL playoff history. the first of four times after catching 81 passes for 995 yards and scoring 9 touchdowns. He followed that performance with a career-high 87 receptions in 1994.

Sharpe signed with the Baltimore Ravens in 2000 as an unrestricted free agent and one year later surpassed Hall of Famer Ozzie Newsome to become the NFL's record holder for receptions and receiving yards by a tight end. After two seasons with the Ravens he returned to Denver to play his final years with the Broncos. He became the career leader in touchdowns by a tight end in his final season. Sharpe's final career numbers read 815 receptions for 10,060 yards and 62 TDs. He recorder ten seasons with 60 or more catches 9:30am – 12pm EST. including three seasons with 80 receptions. Sharpe eclipsed the 1,000-yard mark three times and twice had 10 TDs in a season.

He played in 204 regular season games and started in four AFC championship

games. He was the starting tight end in Denver's back-to-back Super Bowl titles (XXXII and XXXIII) and the Ravens' Super Bowl

Sharpe's 96-yard touchdown reception in the 2000 AFC Championship Game came on a short pass from Trent Dilfer on thirdand-18. The tight end streaked up the middle untouched for the game's first and only touchdown which proved to be all the Ravens needed to secure its first AFC championship and Super Bowl berth. The play remains the

Sharpe led the Broncos six times in receiving and the Ravens once. He was named first-team All-Pro and All-AFC in 1993. 1996. 1997 and 1998 and was selected to the NFL's All-Decade Team of the 1990s.


In 2004 immediately following his retirement Sharpe joined CBS Sports where he spent a decade as a member of their pregame show "The NFL Today." That same year Shannon also launched SIRIUS NFL Radio "Moving the Chains" w/ co-host Bob Papa.

In 2016 Shannon jumped to Fox Sports where he currently co-hosts with Skip Bayless on FS1's "Undisputed" Monday thru Friday

In 2018 He served as a reporter for the Westminster Kennel Club Dog Show live of Fox Sports and in 2019 Sharpe co-hosted the 71st Emmy Awards "Red Carpet Preshow Live" w/Jenny McCarthy and Kelly Osbourne.

none. By the conclusion of her career in

the heptathlon and long jump events she had amassed six Olympic medals (3 gold, 1 silver, 2 bronze) and four World Champion titles over four consecutive Olympic Games. Jackie was the first woman in history to earn more than 7,000 points in the heptathlon and today, over 20 years later, she still holds the world heptathlon record of 7,291 points. She continues to hold the Olympic and national records in the long jump and her 1994 performance in the long jump remains the second longest in history. Jackie's athletic accomplishments have been well documented and remain some of the best ever across all of sports. Less well known are her tireless efforts and remarkable accomplishments off the field as a philanthropist and an advocate for children's education, health issues (in particular asthma from which she has suffered throughout her life), racial equality, social reform and women's rights.
